

## Special Needs Identification

**Recruiter: Read the following out loud to applicants:** At least 10% of PACT’s enrollment is reserved for children who are considered to have Special Needs. A child who has a diagnosed special need is given priority when children are selected for enrollment.

**However, although given priority, a special need *does not guarantee* enrollment.**

The following information is needed to help identify children who have special needs in order to obtain IEPs/IFSPs and relevant paperwork ahead of placement if needed.

**Providing this information is optional and voluntary, and will be kept confidential.**
