

Diaper Changing Procedure

- A. Have the following supplies in the diapering area:
- √ Diapers
 - √ Disposable wipes
 - √ Skin preparations prescribed by the child's doctor or requested by the child's parent;
 - √ disinfecting solution and paper towels for cleaning up
- B. Lay the child on the changing surface, taking care to minimize contact with the child if his/her outer clothes are soiled.
- C. Put on protective gloves.
- D. Remove any soiled clothes and diaper.
- E. Clean the child's bottom from front to back with a fresh disposable wipe or a damp paper towel.
- F. Dispose of diapers, paper towels and diaper wipes into diaper waste pail. Put soiled clothes and cloth diapers into a plastic bag to be sent home with the parent.
- G. Make sure child's clothing is clean and dry before removing gloves.
- H. Remove disposable gloves and place in diaper genie.
- I. Place a clean diaper on the child.
- J. Put clean clothes on the child.
- K. Remove child from the changing table.
- L. Wash child's hands.
- M. Clean and disinfect the diaper changing area.
- N. Wash adult hands.



Surface used for changing area cannot be used for any other purpose.
Containers holding soiled diapers are in lidded with hands-free device.
Diaper containers are closed and contents are not accessible to children.
Changing area is located 3 feet from other areas that children use.

Changing or Assisting a Child with Pull-Ups or Soiled Pants



- 1. Put on disposable gloves when assisting a child with soiled pull-up or underwear.**
- 2. Place the soiled pull-up or underwear in a plastic bag and tie the bag.**
- 3. Place plastic bag in a hands free trashcan with lid, or container to hold soiled clothing.**
- 4. Remove gloves before putting clean pull-up or underwear on child.**
- 5. Wash child's hands.**
- 6. Wash your hands.**
- 7. Give soiled underwear and clothing to an adult. Do not place in bookbag.**
