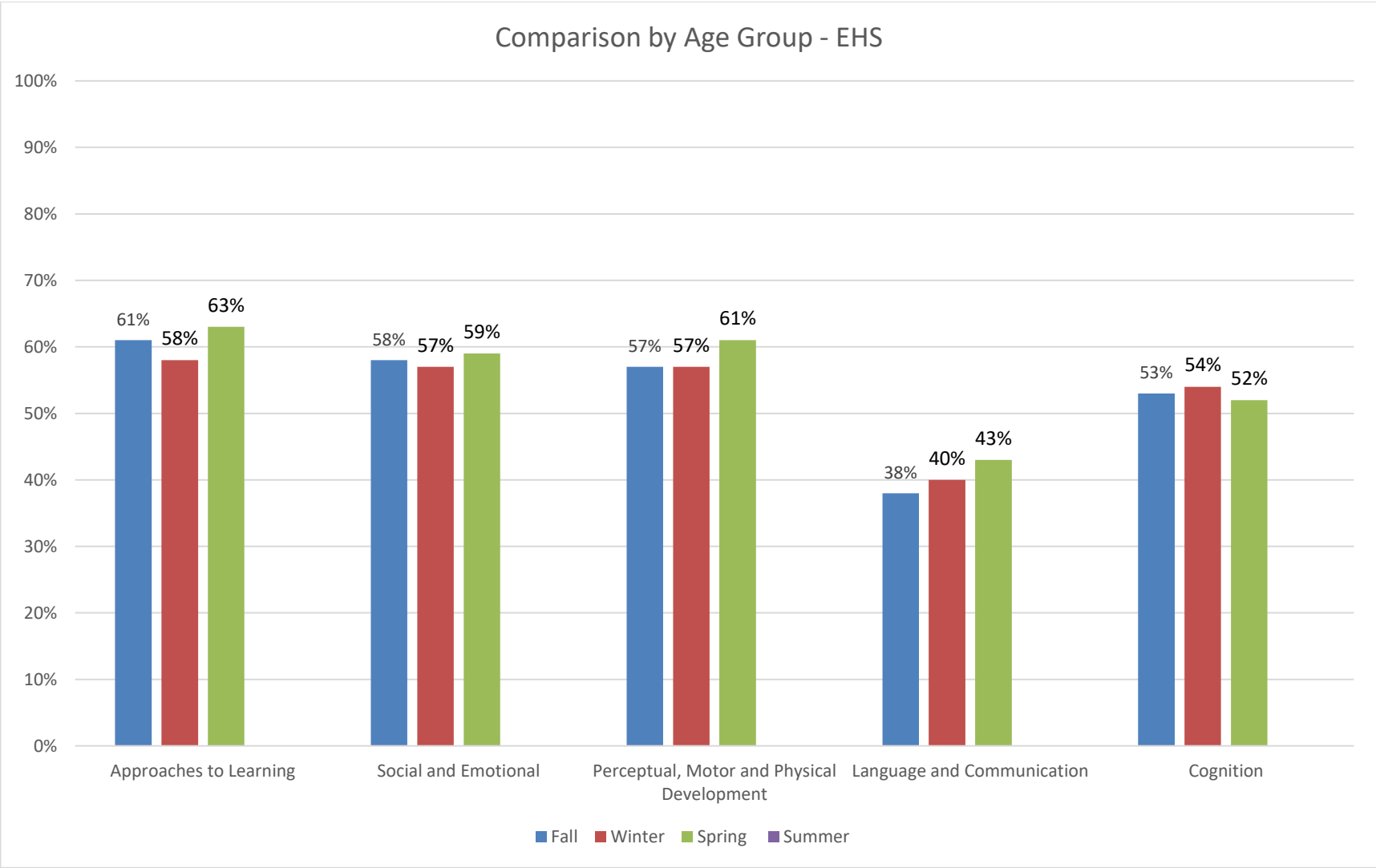


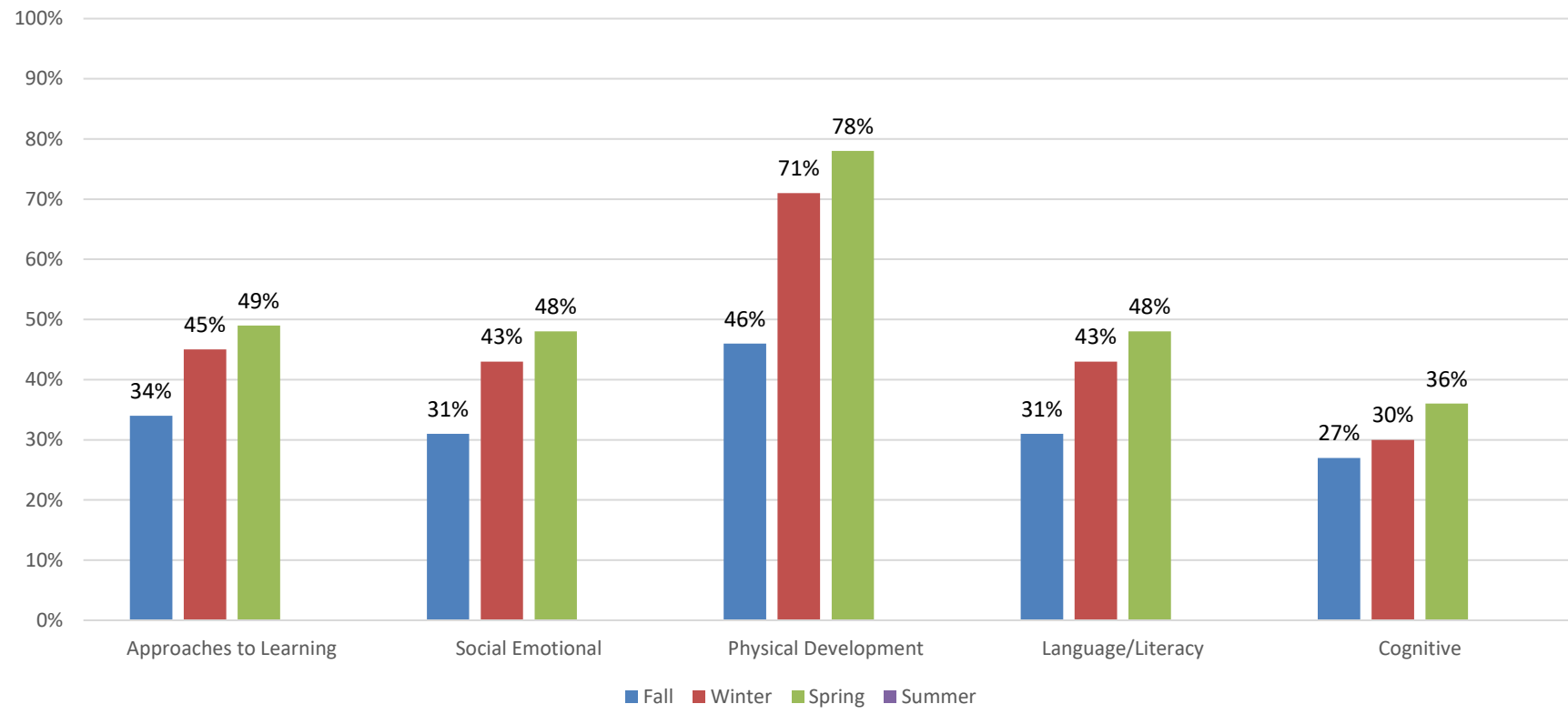
Child Outcomes by Area 2018-19 School Year

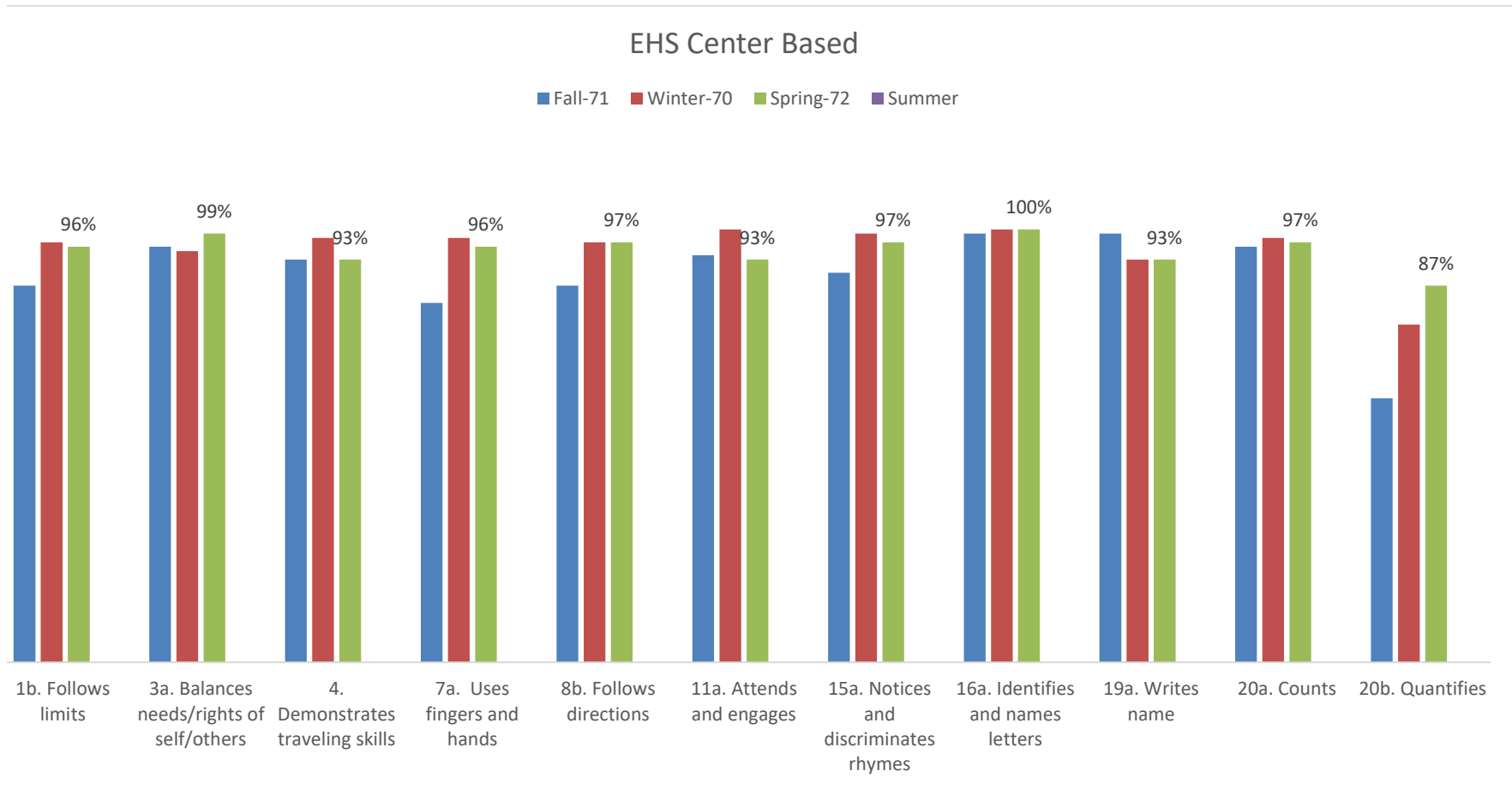
Comparison by Age Group - HS

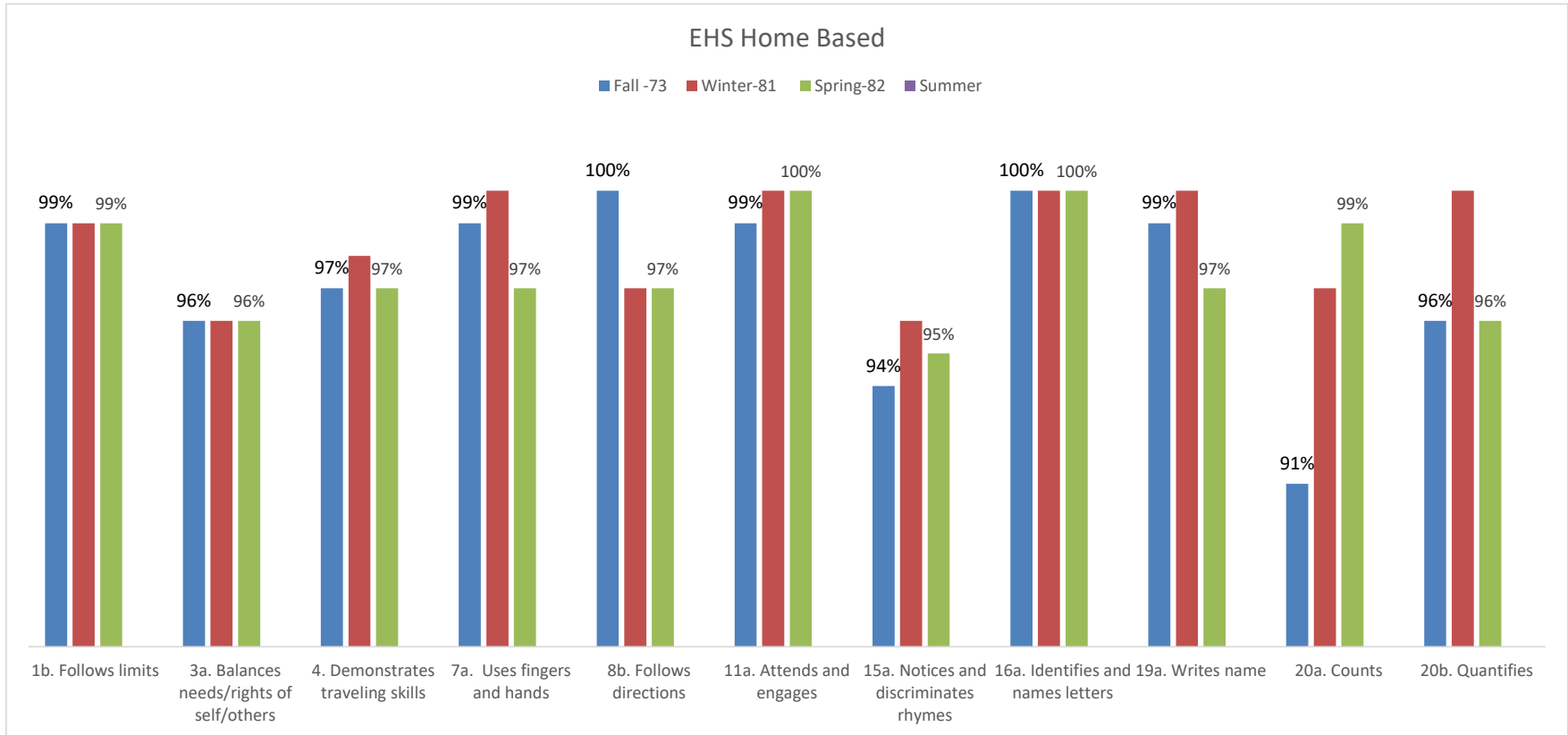

School Readiness Outcomes by Dimension 2018-2019 Program Year For Each Program Option



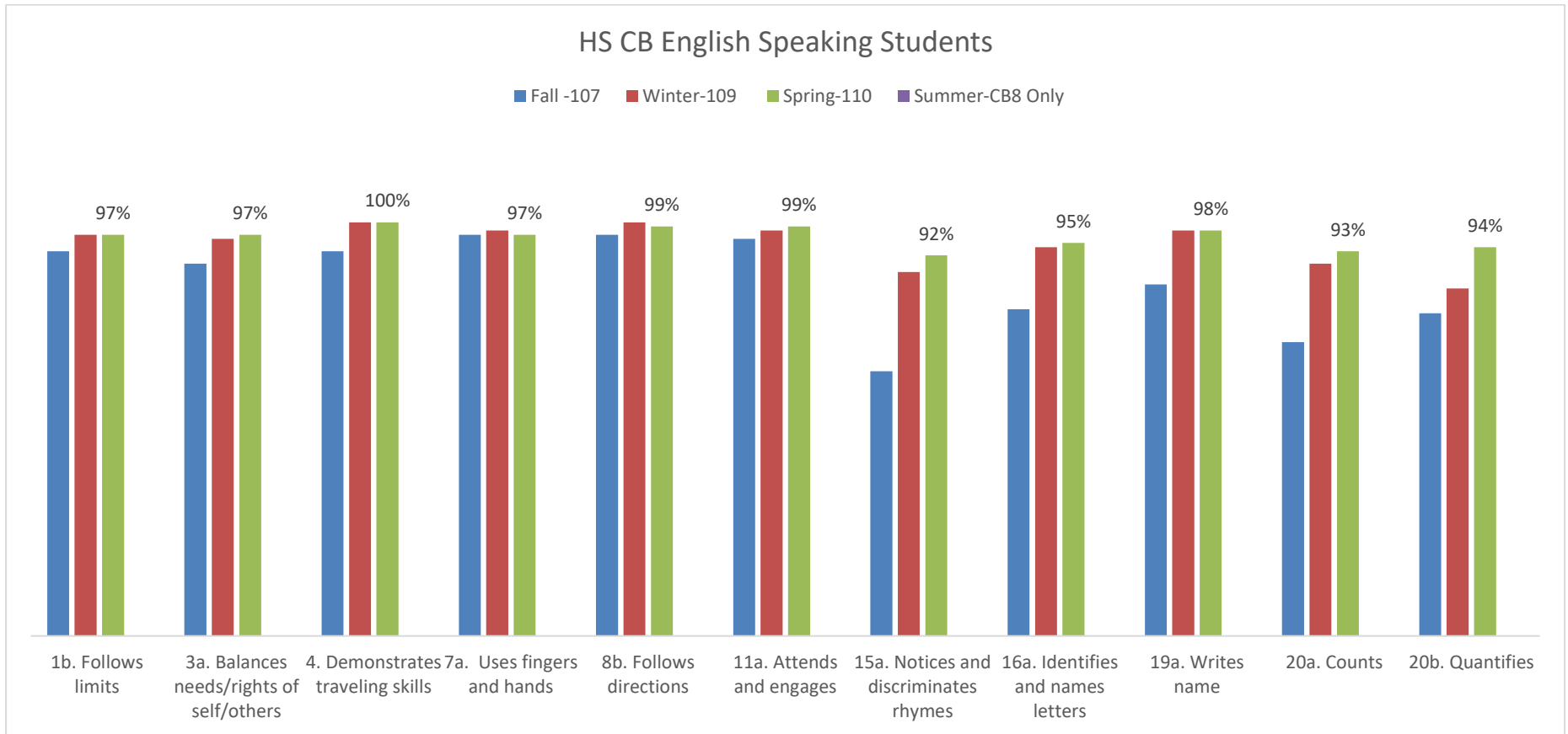
This graph shows the percentage of enrolled children meeting or exceeding expectations for their age level. *Does not include children with IFSPs

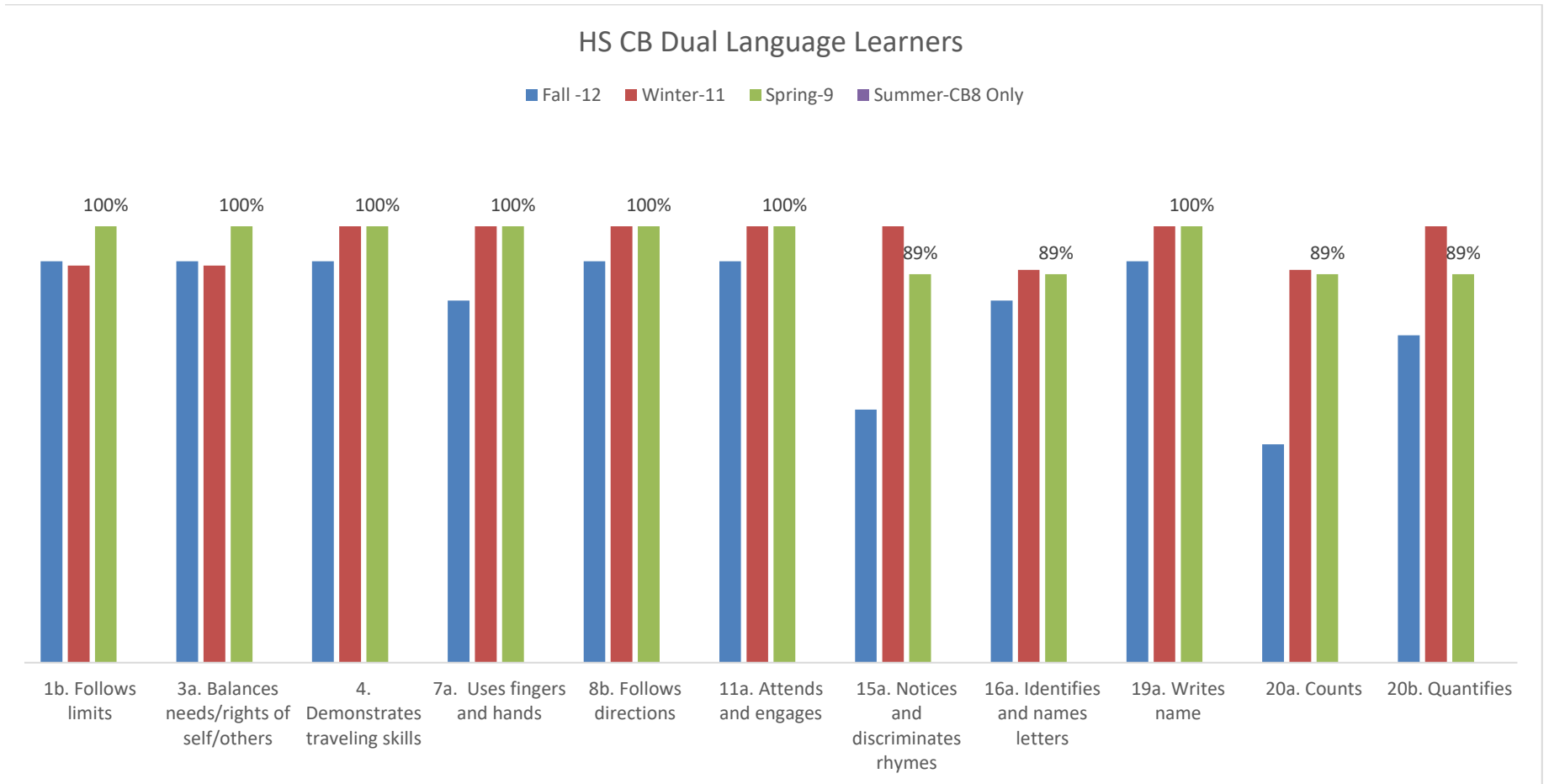
School Readiness Outcomes by Dimension 2018-19 School Year



This graph shows the percentage of enrolled children meeting or exceeding expectations for their age level. *Does not include children with IEPs or DLL's.

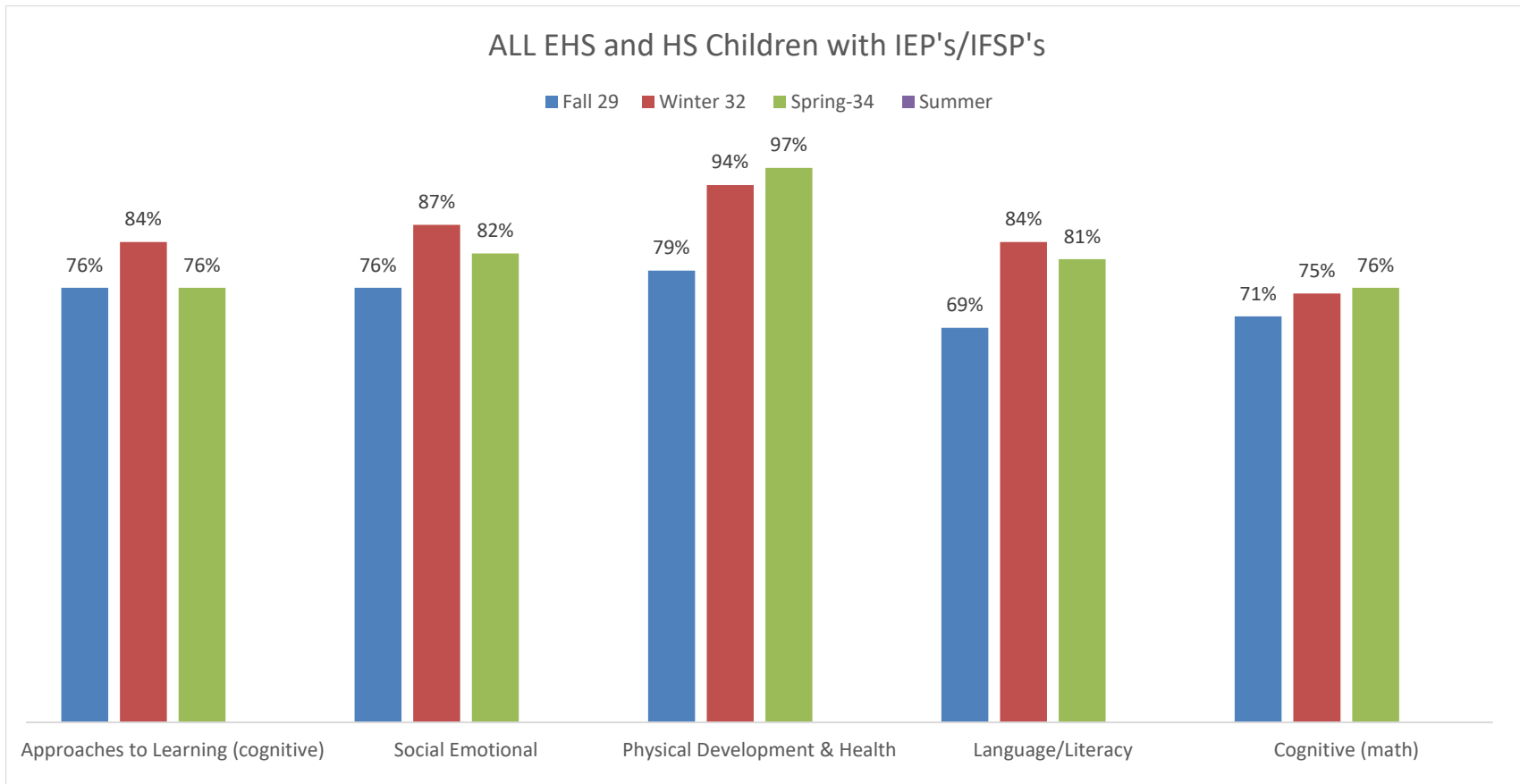
